The Evangelism Committee met on February 16, 2009.

Here are some highlights of activities that occurred *since* that last meeting:

Evangelism's door-to-door Easter campaign was a wonderful success! On Tuesday evening, Feb. 17th, five volunteers met at the church to fold invitational flyers & "stuff" 500 doorknob bags with invitations & candy... Then, on Saturday morning, February 21st, seventeen volunteers placed the doorknob bags on nearly 500 doors in Trinity's neighborhood (*the 'target area' was between Trinity Church and the West Shore Plaza, from Market Street to State Street*). Thanks to Peter Fox, a dozen young folks from our Youth Group joined 2 or 3 kids from our current Confirmation class & a couple parents as we reached-out to our neighbors this Lenten season. Our door-to-door campaign took just under 2 hours to complete.

The next day, February 22nd, Evangelism's Winter "Affirmation of Faith" class joined Trinity's 'church family'. A Potluck meal to welcome our new members was held at 12:30 in Fellowship Hall. Everything went smoothly. The Fellowship Team prepared wonderful food and handled the potluck food items; Women of Trinity set-up tables with tablecloths, flower vases, and table settings; the Evangelism Committee advertised the event, prepared a short program and helped with clean-up. This truly was a 'team effort'. Our thanks to all who participated!!
