

Arts Committee Report to Council

Arts Committee meeting August 18, 2009

Old Business:

Bill Range requested to have copies made of the brochure Tom Drye made with the guidelines for prospective visiting artists. Bill would like to get this out to the local art schools as soon as possible. The Chair will contact Tom to have the PDF file sent to Tim, so the church office can make copies for Bill.

At the end of March, the Chair met with Tom Cooper, the professional patinist, who does color and restoration for Lorann Jacob's statues. Mr. Cooper was to send the Chair an estimate for the work needed to restore the David and the Lambs statue to its original condition. The Chair never received anything further from Mr. Cooper, and she will follow up with him regarding getting an estimate.

The Chair has set a time to meet with Barb Kriebel to examine the chasubles that Dr. Arnold had donated to the church. At this time, the Chair is hoping to just look at the chasubles to get an idea of how large they are and what type of laundering/cleaning they will need. This project is just in the beginning stages.

New Business:

The Arts Committee has been requested to find a copy of the catalog of the artwork of Trinity that was assembled many years ago by Don Catlin. The Chair will call Mr. Catlin to see if he has this. Since Jeff Weaver put a lot of the artwork on Trinity's website, the Chair will check with him as well to see if he has a copy.

Concert Series

Tim mentioned that the Arts Concert Series brochure and letters will need to be mailed out on Friday, August 21. Tom Notestine sent the Chair an email with the Arts Committee members and their phone numbers as well as the list of members who assist with the Trinity Parish mailings. The Chair will call Tom and inform him she will call the Arts Committee members. If he would contact the Parish list, that would be much appreciated.

The Chair will mail Margie Walson a template for helpers for the Concert Series receptions. For the September concert, it will just be a basic reception, and the Chair will organize this one. Bill and Kay Range will pick up the cookies and punch from Giant.

Doug Bonsall emailed the Chair and informed her that the Fellowship Team will be assisting with the Hardy Concert in November and the Christmas Extravaganza in December. The Fellowship Team will assist with the food, while the Arts Committee will be supply the punch. The Chair will get in touch with Margie Walson, Doug Bonsall, Debbie Wilson, Barb

Henderson, Joe Hunter and Tom Drye to arrange a time to meet and discuss these receptions further.

The last topic that was discussed was choir robes. The Chair and the subcommittee for choir robes have looked at numerous catalogs over the past couple of months. The subcommittee is in the beginning stages of this project.

With no further business to be discussed, the meeting was adjourned at 6:55 PM after the Lord's Prayer.
