

Arts Committee Report to Council

Arts Committee meeting September 15, 2009

Old Business:

Bill Range reported that the monthly artist display schedule is set through December 2009. He has compiled a list of names for possible exhibitors in the future. He requested to have copies made of the brochure Tom Drye made with the guidelines for prospective visiting artists. Bill would like to get this out to the local art schools as soon as possible. Tom Drye will send the PDF file sent to Tim, and Tim will forward the PDF to Tom Notestine to have the copies made for Bill.

At the end of March, the Chair met with Tom Cooper, the professional patinist, who does color and restoration for Lorann Jacob's statues. Mr. Cooper was to send the Chair an estimate for the work needed to restore the David and the Lambs statue to its original condition. The Chair never received anything further from Mr. Cooper. She will call Lorann Jacobs.

The Chair met with Barb Kriebel to examine the chasubles that Dr. Arnold had donated to the church. The Chair reported the chasubles will need to be laundered and preserved professionally before any other steps are taken with this project. After a discussion, it was decided by the Arts Committee this should be a project for the Worship Committee. The Arts would like to display the chasubles in the monthly artist exhibit in the future, though.

The Arts Committee was requested to find a copy of the catalog of the artwork of Trinity that was assembled many years ago by Don Catlin. The Chair emailed Mr. Catlin and Jeff Weaver to see if either of them had a copy. Neither of them did. The Chair will check next with the library staff, Will Harmon and look in the archives. If the catalog isn't found after these inquiries, the Chair will submit a memo to be placed in the Trinity Parish. The memo would be requesting if any members of the congregation would know anything about the catalog.

New Business:

Concert Series

The September and October concerts will have a basic reception following each. Bill and Kay Range have agreed to get the cookies and punch for each of these receptions at Giant. The Chair, Margie Walson, and Tom Drye are to meet with Doug Bonsall and Debbie Wilson on Sunday, September 20 to discuss the receptions for the November and December concerts. The Arts Committee and the Fellowship Team are co-sponsoring these receptions.

The Chair reported that Jeannette Kennedy had given money from her estate to the church. The Arts Committee received \$4500. This has been designated to be used for the choir robes. Keeping on that subject, the Chair mentioned that she has reviewed the information she has

received from both the Catholic Shop and Cokesbury. She needs to report her research and information to the choir robe sub-committee.

Patty Marshall provided two articles she came across regarding the church and the arts. The first article was from 1975 and the other one was from 2007.

The Chair will request the office to send out postcards reminding the committee of the next meetings.

With no further business to be discussed, the meeting was adjourned at 7:05 PM after the Lord's Prayer.

The next meeting will be held on Tuesday January 19, 2010.
