

**Call Process Task Force
Report to the Congregation Council
January 11, 2010**

Thanks be to God! Eight people from the nominees approved by the Congregation Council at the December 14, 2009 meeting have accepted the call to serve on the Senior Pastor Call Committee. The nominees and the order in which they were contacted were the result of a deliberate, prayerful discernment process by the Call Process Task Force. The result is a call committee, with approval of the Congregation Council, which will represent the diversity of the congregation in gender, age, ministry experience and worship services attended. Those who have agreed to serve are: Meredith Askey, Bill Foos, Maria Hegedus, Brenda Kaczmarek, Ron Katzman, Betsy Knarr, Charlotte Lazarchik and Tom Reddinger. After receiving information about the call process, the time commitment involved and the level of responsibility involved with serving on the Senior Pastor Call Committee, each person was given two days to prayerfully discern if they were being called by God to serve on the committee. Only then did they answer the call to serve. We request that the Congregation Council approve the eight people recommended by the Call Process Task Force and who have all accepted the call to serve on the call committee.

With the approval of these eight people to serve on the Senior Pastor Call Committee, the work of the Call Process Task Force will be complete and we request that Congregation Council dismiss the Call Process Task Force.
