Some of the accomplishments of this group include the following;

1. Building Removal at 1915 Market Street – Provided recommendation and supported the effort to obtain Congregational Ratification to remove the building located on 1915 Market Street.
2. Development of a new Vision, Mission and Guiding Principle for the Church - Collected and analyzed data from the Congregation to help in the development of a new mission statement. Further developed and supported the ratification by the Congregation to adopt the new mission statement.
3. Second Contemporary Worship Service - Researched and made recommendation to council on ways to relieve contemporary Worship space challenges, resulting in the recommendation of establishing a second contemporary Worship service.
4. Facility and Property Master Planning - Researched and recommended to appoint a Facility and Property Master Planning Task force in order to address long term structural needs of the church to include other adjacent property uses.
5. Transportation Ministry Program - Researched and recommended the establishment of a Transportation Ministry Program, resulting in a Transportation Ministry Task Force to pick up where this committee stopped.
6. Leadership Retreats – in 2008 and 2009 performed as the council’s action committee to organize and host the church’s leadership retreats as well as congregational workshop during the development of the Church’s mission statement.
7. Advise and Assist to other Committees - Provided assistance and recommendations on individuals committees’ own mission statements to include the Council’s own statement.
