

## **EVANGELISM COMMITTEE REPORT TO COUNCIL**

### **March 2010**

The Evangelism Committee met on February 22, 2010 and dedicated most of the meeting to Health Fair planning...

The *primary* goal of Trinity's **Community Health Fair** is to promote, encourage, and educate our community (Trinity Church and beyond), in healthy living *as well as* to provide resources for people experiencing physical, mental and/or spiritual health issues.

#### **The Evangelism Committee has 2 roles of responsibility at the Health Fair:**

First, as Greeters (welcoming people and handing-out maps and schedules).

*We'll commit ourselves to learning as much as we can about the Health Fair, so that we are prepared to answer questions and serve as guides.*

We'll have people located throughout the building to point the way and gently guide our participants. We plan to have a person stationed outside each classroom...at the elevators, etc. Our volunteers will come to Trinity the night before the Health Fair to get a tour and be shown their "stations".

Our second role is to share information on Spiritual Health.

We want to point-out that people are more than physical beings -- we have a physical side, mental side, emotional side, and spiritual side. Our Health Fair will address the *whole* person.

#### **Presentations by Evangelism:**

Trinity's own Robert Richardson works for the Department of Health, and is very interested in the integration of spirituality and health. He will give a presentation on Spirituality and Wellness.

Christopher Couch will do a presentation on "Centering Prayer" (focusing your prayer life). He will lead prayer exercises on a 20-minute cycle so that people may come in throughout the day to take part. Christopher will also have literature available in the Chapel for personal spiritual formation.

And for our younger Health Fair guests, we'll have Veggie Tales videos and discussions running all throughout the day... children can join us anytime. We will be in a room across the hallway or near the children's health and safety presentations.

## **Booths by Evangelism:**

We'll have 2 tables:

1. A Greeter's Booth – With maps of the layout of the church's Health Fair, bags to hold literature, a listing of presentations... Members of the Evangelism Committee along with interested volunteers, will greet people as they enter our building and will staff the Greeter's Booth

2. Spiritual Wellness Booth –We will utilize an 8 ft. table...at one end we'll feature our very active Youth Group with a Powerpoint presentation (*with photos of the Youth Group & keywords associated with YG*), and an "in-house" brochure to hand out. We'll have a couple people there answer any questions our guests might have about YG... On the other end of this table, we'll have a volunteer with Spiritual Wellness handouts such as the Wholeness Wheel, Trinity's Spring 2010 brochure (listing our many learning opportunities here at Trinity), and *other* Spiritual health-related literature.
