HEALTH MINISTRIES:

Blood Pressure screenings continue to be a needed service offered to our members. While we see many of our participants frequently we get new people all the time and identify high pressures with referrals to MD. Some people also appreciate the opportunity to just talk about how they are feeling. _____

Blood Bank: As of the end of February, Trinity is credited with 48 units of blood, well ahead of our goal as usual. The next opportunity to donate will be Saturday, April 17 at the Community Health Fair. Since this date is earlier than usual, the May drive has been moved to June 27.
