In February, Women of Trinity held five circle meetings and a book blog discussion group. Our sewing, prayer shawl, and prayer groups met, 24-hour prayer vigils were held, and cards sent to members.

Our special concerns committee is collecting personal hygiene items and checks from the congregation for health kits to be sent to disaster-struck areas throughout the world. A collection box is in the closet in the Gathering Space. Our visitation ministry is working to incorporate the new cd ministry into our monthly visitation program to homebound members.

All proceeds will be divided equally between the ELCA’s World Hunger program and the Ecumenical Food Pantry at Messiah Lutheran in Harrisburg.
