

EVANGELISM COMMITTEE REPORT TO COUNCIL April 2010

With Trinity's **Community Health Fair** less than a week away, final preparations are in full swing:

From Thursday evening, April 8th through Sunday, April 11th, "Temple Talks" were held at each worship service, inviting our fellow parishioners to the health fair...

On Saturday, April 10th, we conducted a door-to-door campaign inviting our neighbors to the fair (*doorknob bags containing Health Fair flyers were hung on **504** doors – mostly south of Market Street between the West Shore Plaza and 21st Street*).

We asked all Health Fair "greeters" and "guides" to come to Trinity *this* Friday night (April 16th - *the night before the fair*), to learn the layout of the event and be shown their "stations" -- Lori Anne McBride will give 2 tours of the facility that night... Volunteers who arrive at 5:00 PM, will first be briefed on the Health Fair, then given a tour of its layout from 5:30 to 6:15... And volunteers who arrive at 6:30 PM, will be briefed on the Health Fair, then given a tour from 7:00 to 7:45.

Our Health Fair "greeters" and "guides" have volunteered to serve at Trinity on Saturday from either 8:30 AM to 12:30 PM or 11:00 AM to 3:00 PM (*we planned some overlapping of shifts to "cover" the busier fair times*).

Things are truly coming together!

On April 11th, our first **Affirmation of Faith Class** for the Spring began... Around a dozen people attended the class. Classes will *continue* each Sunday from 9:15 am to 10:30 am through May 16th. These new members will be received into our church "family" on May 23rd. Council members and chairpersons are *always* welcome to drop-in during our weekly classes. And please mark your calendars, now, for a special potluck luncheon, Sunday, May 23rd, at which you'll have the opportunity to "meet & greet" our newest members!
