Report Items

1. My role as Interim Sr. Pastor includes:
 - a. Maintaining current level of ministry and programming.
 - b. Guiding the Staff, leadership and the congregation through the 5 Developmental Tasks of an interim time (see hand-out).
 - c. Consult, Observe, Reflect – be a mirror.

8. Working to standardize the goal-setting process for program staff. Will work on that after evaluations are completed.
9. Have begun planning for the Fall Pastor’s Bible Study.
10. Attending the Graduation Ceremonies at Gettysburg Seminary on May 14 to hand out diplomas.
11. Attending the DE-MD Synod Assembly, June 10-14 at the Eisenhower Conference Center in Gettysburg.
