We are fed by Word and Sacrament in worship at Trinity Lutheran Church. The Worship Ministry Team helps to manage our six weekly services and their consistency with the liturgical worship practices of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America. Ushers, greeters, devotional booklets, worship times, decoration of the worship spaces, bulletin covers, altar care, and flowers are but some of the details.

In September of 2018, Trinity began worshiping on a Sunday morning at two times only. Worship services in both the Nave and Fellowship Hall occur at 8:30 and 11:00. Adjustments have included re-thinking the order of services so that the single preacher for the Sunday can deliver the sermon four times within the time frame.

During Holy Week, the Team provides the experience of "The Way of the Cross." Names of loved ones graced the frontals (altar cloths) for All Saints Sunday. Flowers decorate worship spaces on major festivals and later may be delivered to sick or shut-in members or become plantings in the gardens around Trinity with the help of other TLC teams. Frontals were created and used for several months in Pentecost as part of the Capital Appeal.
