Since we would not ordinarily meet in July or August, but are due to the nature of the pandemic, I wanted to inform the council of a few things going on in relation to the pandemic and our ministries response to it.

Community Outreach Ministries and the July Giving Tree

Thank you to everyone who supported the July Giving Tree! The Community Outreach Ministries team raised \$2115. We collected 9 large banana boxes of food for the Ecumenical Food Pantry, 200 items for the Christ Lutheran Medical Mission, \$400 worth of donations to the Camp Curtin YMCA, and a trunk full of school supplies for Trinity Tutors. This event and fundraising were a success! Additionally, the team met for a special meeting July 21 to talk about how Trinity might financially support our ministries and other organizations during Covid-19. The team voted to give \$1000 to the Christian Churches United Covid-19 Response Fund and \$500 to Camp Hill's Lion Foundation for technology scholarships for kids in need during distance learning.
