MOTION:

Dave Rupnik moved to approve the revised scope of work and costing for the Phase 2 Renovations, per the Campbell Associates letter of September 21, 2020, last revised October 8, 2020 at a cost of \$852,084.49. Mike Ackers seconded.

Discussion ensued. Motion passed.

MOTION:

Motion for 1959 Market Street:

Finance moves that Congregation Council approve an internal loan of \$240,000 from Quasi Endowment at 1.5% to be paid back to Trinity and to negotiate the letter of intent between Trinity Congregation Council and the Lower Susquehanna Synod for a lease with a 10-year term for \$3,000 a month rent and \$20,000 upfront toward construction costs, from the Lower Susquehanna Synod.

Discussion ensued. Motion passed.

MOTION:

Mike Akers moves to allow the 1959 market street Committee approval to draft a letter of intent for lease with the Lower Susquehanna Synod, to enter negations for leasing the 1959 Market Street property. This lease should be a 10-year agreement. The funding of this should be \$240,000 approved from Finance Committee with an internal rate of 1.5%. Additionally, the monthly lease should be \$3,000 plus \$20,000 upfront toward construction costs and Trinity will pay the utilities for this property. The internal loan will be used to build the property out to accepting bid from Weidner Construction services. Ellen Ney seconded.

Discussion ensued. Motion passed.
