

A&P Committee Report to the Council  
May 7, 2021

The A&P Committee met on Wednesday, May 5, 2021. The main topic this month was the work done by the Faith Formation Task Force. Serena Fedor, chair of the task force, presented a comprehensive report outlining work done by the task force to identify the current needs and future opportunities for faith formation at Trinity. The committee discussed and approved the report, which Serena will present to council. Draft job descriptions for the recommended positions will be completed as soon as possible to be presented for approval by the committee and then to council. The unused funds budgeted for the positions previously filled by Peter Fox and Kelly Falck will cover the recommended positions for the remainder of 2021.

There are two funded, but vacant, position, one for digital technology and the other for a building use coordinator/daytime receptionist. Possible candidates for those positions have been identified and will be reported on soon.

Also discussed were plans by Pastor Horner for a mini-sabbatical, scheduled for August 3 – 27. He will present a report of his activities upon his return. As there are no additional fiscal implications, the committee approved this plan.

The next meeting for the committee is scheduled for Wednesday, June 1.
