Report to Congregation Council
November 2017

The P&C Committee has not met since the last council meeting. Here are some updates of what we have been working on:

Capital Campaign Presentations – Much of our work in the past month has been focused on the rolling out of information regarding the Capital Campaign and Building Plan updates. Working alongside the property committee, we created the presentations for both the October 29th and November 12th meetings. Using the information from the October 29th presentation, a video was created to give people a better understanding of all the activity that happens at Trinity. This video is on our YouTube Channel, our website and will be shown at the start of the November 12th meeting.

Welcome Video for Website - Zach Weiss has agreed to film a welcome video for the new website. He has laid out an excellent story board and is ready to begin filming. A request has been made for video equipment to be used for this video as well as a new "Media Ministry" that we are looking to form out of the P&C committee. The request for funds has been submitted to Council. Once we get approval we can move forward with this project.

Website – The new website continues to be working well. Jeff Weaver continues to monitor the site and do the daily updates. One change to highlight is the addition of the complete 10:45 am contemporary service. The audio is combined with an image to create a file that is loaded onto our YouTube Channel for anyone to enjoy.

Gathering Space – Dave Rupnik has worked up some options for a redesign of the Welcome Board inside the front doors. This board would include a TV that would display the daily events at Trinity (kind of like the lobby of a conference center.) A request for this change has been submitted as part of the 2018 P&C Budget.

Social Media – We continue to work hard to create a platform on social media where we can share our events and activities as well as draw in members of the community. I encourage everyone to Like us on Facebook (@trinitycamphill) and join our Members group (Trinity Camp Hill Members.) I also encourage you to subscribe to our YouTube Channel (Trinity Camp Hill.) You will find here our weekly sermons, Contemporary Service and Contemporary Children's messages. Sharing our posts, videos, and pages from our website are a great way for our message to be shared outside of the church.
