Visit the labyrinth in Fellowship Hall during Holy Week this year. Travel its twists and turns as a means to pray and reflect on the road to Easter Sunday. Monday, March 26, through Friday, March 30 during the hours that the building is open, except for Tuesday evening.

Trinity's Security Task Force has submitted its report to Congregation Council with recommendations to help increase building security and the safety of our members and guests. The first of these recommendations is to keep **three doors locked at all times: Market Street entrance, the outside kitchen door, and the door at the end of the kitchen hallway.** Thank you for your patience and cooperation as we strive to make Trinity a safe environment for everyone.
