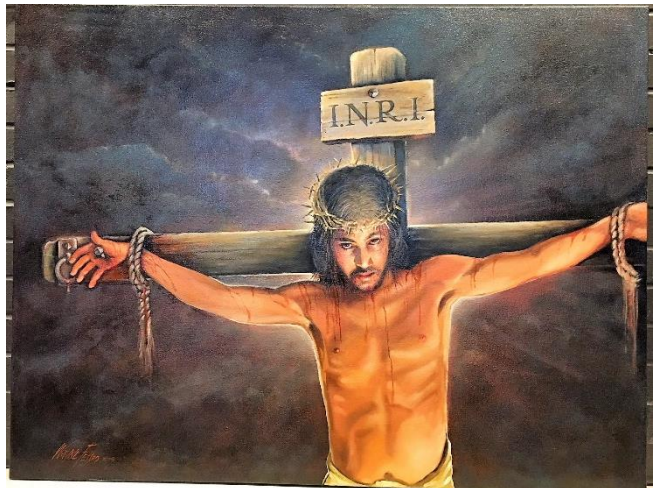

A Trinity member for 58 years, she was a Chancel Choir member, Sunday School and Bible School teacher, Trinity Tutor, landscape gardener, and more. She also worked for more than 25 years as a Contact Helpline volunteer. She was

devoted to her family and is survived by her husband of 69 years, three children, eight grandchildren, fifteen great-grandchildren, and one great-great grandchild.
