

Report to Council – KAIROS Leadership Committee – April 2018

We have revised the timeline of the Capital Appeal. Post cards introducing the appeal and events were included in the Easter bulletins. The timing of the dinner theatres remains the same. April 15th will be a “soft kickoff” and will include the first dinner theatre, a four page brochure will be available, an appeal commercial is slated for release, and a Trinity historical timeline will decorate the gathering space. Pastor Driver-Bishop will preach at the Sunday services.

Cottage meetings and lead gift events will continue throughout the months of April and May. During the second week of May a full sized brochure, the Giving Story Booklet, and pledge cards will be sent to all households. We expect to “Celebrate the Appeal” with the announcement of how much has been committed from lead givers and church leadership by May 20th. A goal tracker will be added to the gathering space and an additional event is being considered.

Benefits of this revised timeline include allowing us more time to have conversations with lead givers and hopefully maximize our initial donations. It also gives our communications team additional time to compile and distribute all of the necessary information. Efforts will continue throughout the summer with updates and events as necessary.

I cannot stress enough the importance we, on the KAIROS committee and others, place on success of this appeal. The proposed updates to our facility will assure the future of Trinity as a leadership church; virtually every aspect of our planned improvements tie directly to safety, security, and accessibility which are now lacking.
