The P&C Committee met on April 23. I was unable to attend, but Stephanie Maurer ran the meeting on my behalf. Our next meeting will be held on July 23.

Here are the things that we have completed on since the last update.

- **Appeal Videos – “Trinity Through the Years” and “Trinity, Through Their Eyes”** - Both of these videos were released at the dinner theatre events. They are posted on the website and our YouTube channel. We have also been showing them in the Gathering Space. We will be showing “Trinity Through the Years” at the start of worship services on Thursday, May 17<sup>th</sup>, Saturday, May 19<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, May 20<sup>th</sup>. Big thank you to Zach Weiss and Serena Fedor who worked so hard on the production of these videos.
- **New Posters of Renderings and Floor Plans** – All of these new posters have been completed and have been on display since April 15<sup>th</sup>. Thank you to Dan Reed for working with the architects to get us the new renderings. They have been very helpful in our conversations with folks about the ideas for the new spaces.
- **Full Size Brochure** – The full-size brochure and pledge card is complete!! I received mine in the mail on Saturday and hopefully you have also received your copy as well. If not, it should be coming any day. HUGE thank you to Stephanie Maurer who carried this project on her shoulders. It is fabulous.
- **Birthday Party, Dinner Theatres and Gathering Space Ambassadors/Story Tellers** – Thank you to all the ambassadors and story tellers who helped to communicate our story of the appeal at the Birthday Party, Dinner Theatres and in the Gathering Space on Sunday mornings. Also, thank you to those of you who attended the cottage meetings as an ambassador. I really appreciate all the efforts put in by the Ambassador and Story Telling teams.

Here are the things that we are continuing to work on:

- **Gathering Space Update** – This week we will switch out the History information on the Art Wall to more information about the appeal. We will be hanging the renderings in this space along with a “goal tracker.” Check it out this Sunday!

- **New Directory** – We have been working together with Pastor Brock and Bill Bishop to determine how we can gather new directory information (address/phone number/emails/picture) and distribute to the congregation. Pastor Brock and Bill attended a training session on this program. We will continue to work with them over the summer and plan to roll something out by the fall.
