Dear Trinity Member:

I am pleased to report that on Friday, April 27, under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, Trinity's Congregation Council accepted the recommendation of the Call Committee and nominated the Rev. Seminarian Elizabeth E. Frey to fill the position of Associate Pastor at Trinity Lutheran Church.

Seminarian Frey is a native of Lancaster County and a graduate of Gettysburg College. She will graduate in May from the Lutheran School of Theology at Chicago. Enclosed is an introductory letter that includes her bio and photo.

Council has called a **special congregational meeting** for the sole purpose of considering and voting on the call of Seminarian Frey to Trinity. You will be able to hear her preach at all weekend services on May 12-13. Service times are Saturday evening, May 12, at 5:30; and Sunday morning, May 13, at 8:30, 9:00, 10:45, and 11:00.

No matter which service you attend, you will be able to consider and vote on the call immediately following that service. That's because the special congregational meeting will be called to order at 6:30 pm on Saturday, May 12, for the specific purpose of voting; it will then be recessed and reopened on Sunday, May 13, at 9:30 am, 10:00 am, 11:45 am, and again at 12:15 pm. The votes will be counted at the conclusion of the last session.

Please plan to be present at one of the services on May 12 or 13 and prayerfully participate in this important event in the life of Trinity Church.

If you would like to meet Seminarian Frey prior to hearing her preach and prior to the special meeting, we have scheduled a fellowship time on Saturday, May 12, from 4:00 pm to 5:00 pm.

Letter from Rev. Seminarian Elizabeth Frey Candidate for Associate Pastor at Trinity

Hello, Trinity!
