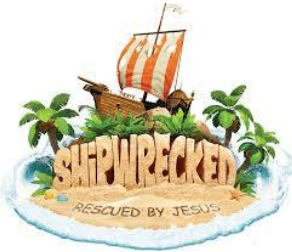
Parking lot update from Property Committee
