Completed:

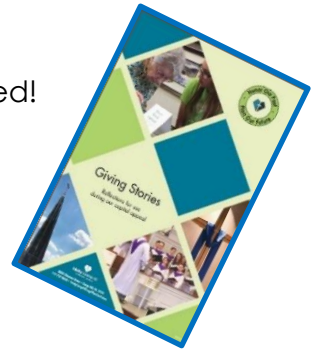
- Retaining wall installed

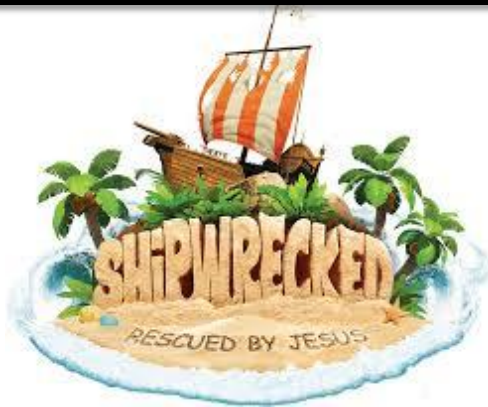
