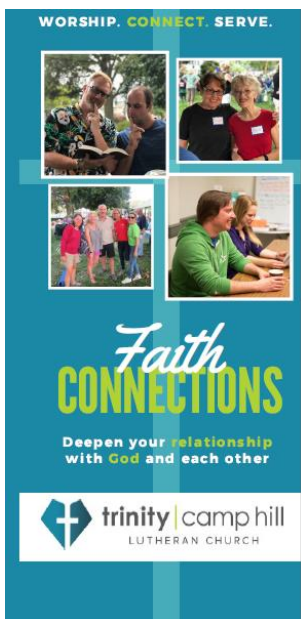

The Jan.-Aug. budget amounts show 8/12 of the total yearly budget, not taking into account expected fluctuations of receipts and expenses. August typically has lower offerings, plus there were additional expected expenses, leading to a month-end deficit.

Thanks to your generous gifts to our capital appeal, we have made payments of \$368,196 so far for the parking lot project, borrowing only \$45,000 from our line of credit.
