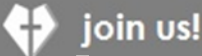

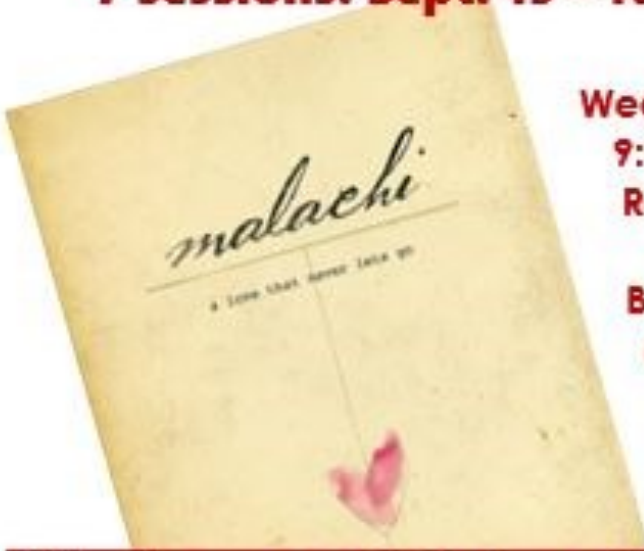

The Jan - August budget amounts show 8/12 of the total amount budgeted for the entire year, and do not take into account expected fluctuations of receipts and expenses. Because of the summer travel season, August traditionally has lower offerings. This month we also had additional expected expenses, leading to a deficit at the end of the month.

Trinity has made payments of \$368,196 so far for the parking lot project and we have only had to borrow \$45,000 from our Line of Credit. **Thank you for your generous giving to our Capital Appeal.**
