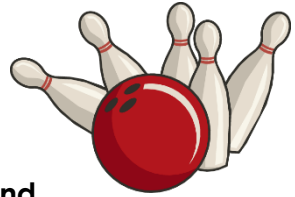


Hey, Youth, this is for you!

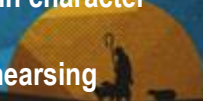
