We ended the year having spent slightly more than we budgeted, resulting in a deficit of \$7,896. Fortunately, one year ago, Trinity's Finance Committee re-established an "Operating Fund Reserve Account," allocating \$10,000 in order that monies would be available for budget deficits or other unforeseen budget/operating fund situations. In the case of the 2018 deficit, the Finance Committee authorized the release of reserve account funds to reimburse the operating fund for that amount.


