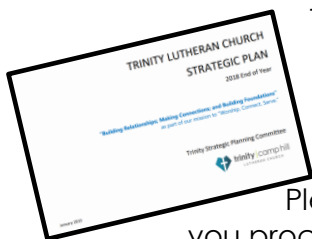

The beds shown above are set up evenings, December through March, for the Winter Overnight Safe Haven program, located near the Farm Show complex. Around 20 men can sleep in this clean, warm, dry space instead of on the street. Two volunteers make coffee, chat, and sleep in an adjoining room. Right down the hall are the staff of Susquehanna Harbor Safe Haven, part of Christian Churches United, or CCU, of which Trinity is a member. From Becky:
