Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent, when God calls us to reflect on the meaning of Christ's death and resurrection.

The imposition of ashes—receiving ashes in the sign of the cross on your forehead—sets the tone for Lent with the

reminder that “You are dust, and to dust you shall return.” At the same time, the sign of the cross is a reminder that Jesus' death and resurrection bring us hope.

Many think of Lent as a time to *give things up*—to make sacrifices—as Jesus did for us. But Lent can also be a time to *take things on*—to make deliberate choices to live your life like Christ has called you to do—to serve all people, following the example of Jesus.

This Lenten season our **Faith Connect Kids!** will take on the task of serving others through “**40 Days Kindness!**” We'll share God's love with friends and family both in the church and in the community. Watch for updates on our projects and how you can get involved!
