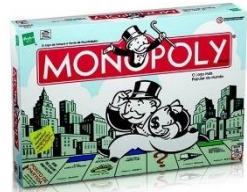

This Lenten season, Faith Connect Kids! is taking on the task of serving others through **40 Days of Kindness!**

We'll share God's love with friends and family both in the church and in the community.

Last week we served others by making "service coupons."

### Week 2: March 17 • "Meet People's Needs"

Let's face it—we can all be a little selfish. At times, we expect others to pay attention to our needs while forgetting to do the same for others. So this week we talk about meeting other people's needs.

- In our story, Peter says to serve others using the gifts God has given us (1 Peter 4:10-11).
- In class, we'll discuss how our kids can pay attention, be encouragers, and use their gifts of kindness to change someone's day. A simple smile, kind word, or a high five can make a big impact. We'll make bookmarks to give to kids in the inner-city schools where our tutors serve. We'll write special notes of encouragement on each bookmark.
- At home, we'll ask kids/families to collect new or gently used books for Harrisburg city schools and Cumberland County Children & Youth Services, and to include a note of encouragement with each book.
