Faith Connect Kids! 40 Days of Kindness

This Lenten season, Faith Connect Kids! is serving others through **40 Days of Kindness!** We'll share God's love with friends and family both in the church and in the community.

Last week we talked about using our gifts to meet other people's needs. We made bookmarks with words of encouragement to give to kids in the inner-city schools

Week 3 – March 24 “Jesus Feeds 5000”

Have you ever thought “If only I won the lottery, I could change the world!” or “If I had extra time, I could volunteer more!” Now think about our kids--young, probably haven't saved a lot of money, and time is short between school, activities, and just being kids! In terms of time, talent, and treasure, that's not a lot to offer, so how can they possibly serve others?

The answer to that question is in this week's story, when Jesus takes the lunch of just one boy and uses it to feed 5,000 people (John 6:1-13). This miracle teaches that God lets us do big things even with small gifts.

In class this week, our kids will decorate a paper lunch bag. They'll take the bag home and, with their families, collect non-perishable food items. All food will be donated to New Hope Ministries. The kids will see that even small gifts can make a big difference in many lives.



No act of kindness, no matter how small, is ever wasted.
