What in the world is Flat Jesus?



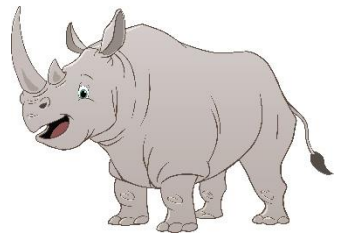
