Pay \$7.00, no bulletin listing. Look for the table in the Gathering Space May 26 and June 2; or order and pay at the church office during weekday business hours.

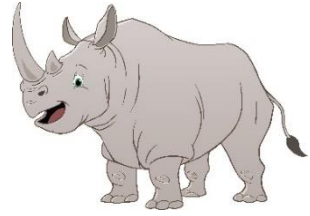
