Results are in for our Mardi Gras in May

Wow and thank you! Our Mardi Gras in May event attracted 200+ people and raised \$11,000 for the youth ministry portion of our Lower Susquehanna Synod's *Always Being Made New* campaign. The night was full: good food, games for the kiddos, the "Lutheran Glee" skit by our talented Youth Group, a Lutheran Family Feud game, a young king (Max Askey) and queen (Ally Shepler), and a successful silent auction with Mary Kay Fager paintings donated by Charlie Fager and gift baskets donated by others. **Congratulations to Mitzi Jones** of our Community Outreach Ministries Team for chairing this event. Mary Ellen Hettinger and the Missions Team are looking forward to putting together the 2021 fundraiser.

Guatemala: Did you know? And will you help?

- **It will cost the Trinity Team around \$1,000 in baggage fees to transport 1400 pounds of supplies and donated goods to Guatemala when the team travels there in July.** Shipping donated goods and supplies directly to Guatemala is expensive and difficult; the best way to transport things like medicines, blankets, clothing, and school supplies is in checked baggage carried by our volunteers. In addition to VBS supplies, we have been asked to transport many other items. **Your \$\$ donations will help greatly with this expense.**
- Now through the end of July, **Tree4Hope is running a matching gift campaign to finish building Hope Academy.** All donations up to \$75k will be matched by an anonymous donor, so now is a great time to give. Donate directly to Tree4Hope or through Trinity; if you donate through Trinity, just be sure to designate your gift for Tree4Hope.
- **You can make a difference in the life of an individual child by becoming a sponsor.** It's just \$216 a year, or \$18 a month, to sponsor nutrition, therapy, music lessons, and more for a child at the children's home Trinity will be visiting.
