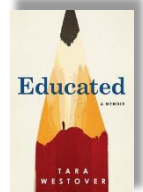


August 3-4: Meet the Troesters and join them for lunch

Hey, Youth, it's a pool party!

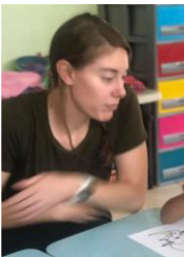
