Will you help Dauphin County prison inmates find a church to connect with upon their release?

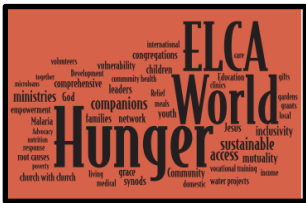
