## Donate school supplies

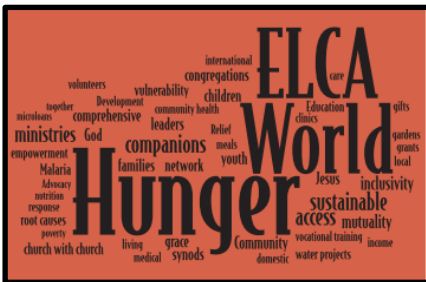
**Look for the box in the Gathering Space to donate school supplies:** plastic
