Yes, you'll get less sleep than usual, and you might be hesitant to make this commitment, but the experience will help you appreciate your own comfy bed even more. Sign up in the Gathering Space starting January.

**A heartfelt thanks for your generous response to our Giving Tree!** Your expressions of God's love via gift cards and items for others will touch many people, far and near. In gift cards, you gave \$780 for seminarians, \$725 for prison ministry, \$720 for Ecumenical Food Party, \$400 for Camp Curtin Y, \$325 for Bethesda Mission, and \$145 for Rocky Boy's Indian Reservation, plus nearly 300 layette items for Rocky Boy's.
