### Trinity's End-of-Year Operating Budget Snapshot

- Thank you for your gifts supporting the work of Christ at Trinity.
- We have some good news and some not-so-good news. The good news is that our capital appeal received funds of more than \$300,000 this year for our needed safety improvements. Thanks to you, much of that work can begin in late spring.
- Unfortunately, our day-to-day operating budget fell short by \$53,428, even with staff and ministry leaders holding down their expenses. (The contributions and offerings to our budget were short by \$51,545.)
- The Finance Committee will recommend to Council how to make up this difference by using funds other than our day-to-day operating monies.
- Your giving generously to Trinity makes a huge difference in what we can do together. Please consider increasing your 2020 contributions so we can continue to meet the needs of our community.
