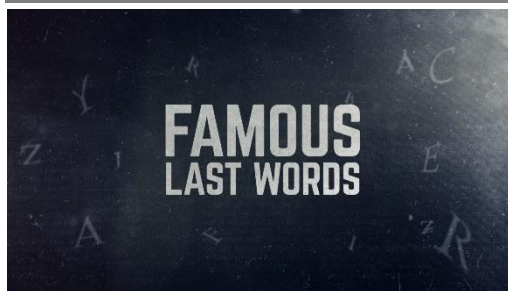

**Famous last words**  
**come in a lot of**  
**different forms.** Some  
 are thought-provoking

and profound, some are ironic and sad, and some are surprisingly ordinary and normal. But no matter what, there's a reason they're memorable. We remember last words not because of what was said, but because of when they were said. These words have power because of their context. For the next few weeks, **we'll look at some of the last words of Jesus – famous last words most definitely worth remembering.** As Jesus journeyed with his disciples toward Jerusalem, he knew his death was approaching. And the things he said in the moments leading up to and following his crucifixion are certainly worth remembering. In studying this part of his life, we'll see that Jesus' famous last words can help us take some of the first steps toward living the life God that intended for us.

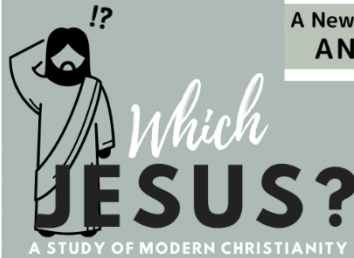
