**Suspension of activities due to Flu/COVID-19**

**Effective immediately**, in order to ensure the health, safety, and well-being of our church family/community, we are suspending all church activities, including worship, through Tuesday, March 31. **The building is closed.**

**Please know this decision was not made lightly**; it has been discussed with all gravity, and it conforms to a recommendation by Bishop James Dunlop. Churches, schools, and organizations locally and statewide are doing their part to try to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. The attempts to mitigate are especially important because — as noted by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention — “COVID-19 is a new disease and we are still learning how it spreads, the severity of illness it causes, and to what extent it may spread in the United States.”

**Our suspension of activities does NOT mean that your spiritual health is suspended.** To that end, we offer the following:

- **Remember to pray** for all whose health is compromised, for the wisdom and safety of our leaders and health professionals, and for strength and calm as we navigate this uncertain time.

- **Our pastors will continue to minister to the sick and hospitalized** as they are able as Jesus taught and modeled for us.
