Suspension of activities due to Flu/COVID-19

Effective immediately, in order to ensure the health, safety, and well-being of our church family/community, we are suspending all church activities, including worship, through Tuesday, March 31. **The building is closed.**

Please know this decision was not made lightly; it has been discussed with all gravity, and it conforms to a recommendation by Bishop James Dunlop. Churches, schools, and organizations locally and statewide are doing their part to try to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. The attempts to mitigate are especially important because — as noted by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention — “COVID-19 is a new disease and we are still learning how it spreads, the severity of illness it causes, and to what extent it may spread in the United States.”

Our suspension of activities does NOT mean that your spiritual health is suspended. To that end, we offer the following:

- **Remember to pray** for all whose health is compromised, for the wisdom and safety of our leaders and health professionals, and for strength and calm as we navigate this uncertain time.
- Here at Trinity, **we will post a weekly sermon** on our website at www.TrinityCampHill.org on Saturdays around 5 pm.
- **Our pastors will continue to minister to the sick and hospitalized** as they are able as Jesus taught and modeled for us.
