Don't just listen to the Sermon...Ponder how you can live it!

Use these questions as a starting point to dive deeper into the sermon each week. Can be used individually, with family and friends, or with your Life-group!

1. Has your faith ever felt dead? What were the circumstances? How did you handle it?
2. How has the Spirit been active in your life? Have you been reignited from a dead pile of ash? Or have you felt like your fire has simply never gone out?
3. What was “the rush of a violent wind” like in your life? When did you experience it? Or has the Spirit been more like a steady force?
4. “Parthians, Medes, Elamites, and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya belonging to Cyrene, and visitors from Rome, both Jews and proselytes, Cretans and Arabs—in our own languages we hear them speaking about God’s deeds of power.” (Acts 2:9-11) Can you relate to these countries, these languages? What are some modern equivalents? Do we think God would *Really* send the Spirit to *those* people?
5. Our gospel lesson said, “for as yet there was no Spirit, because Jesus was not yet glorified.” (John 7:39b) Have you ever felt like the Spirit has abandoned you, left you hanging high and dry? Or have you felt like the Spirit has yet to come into your life?

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
