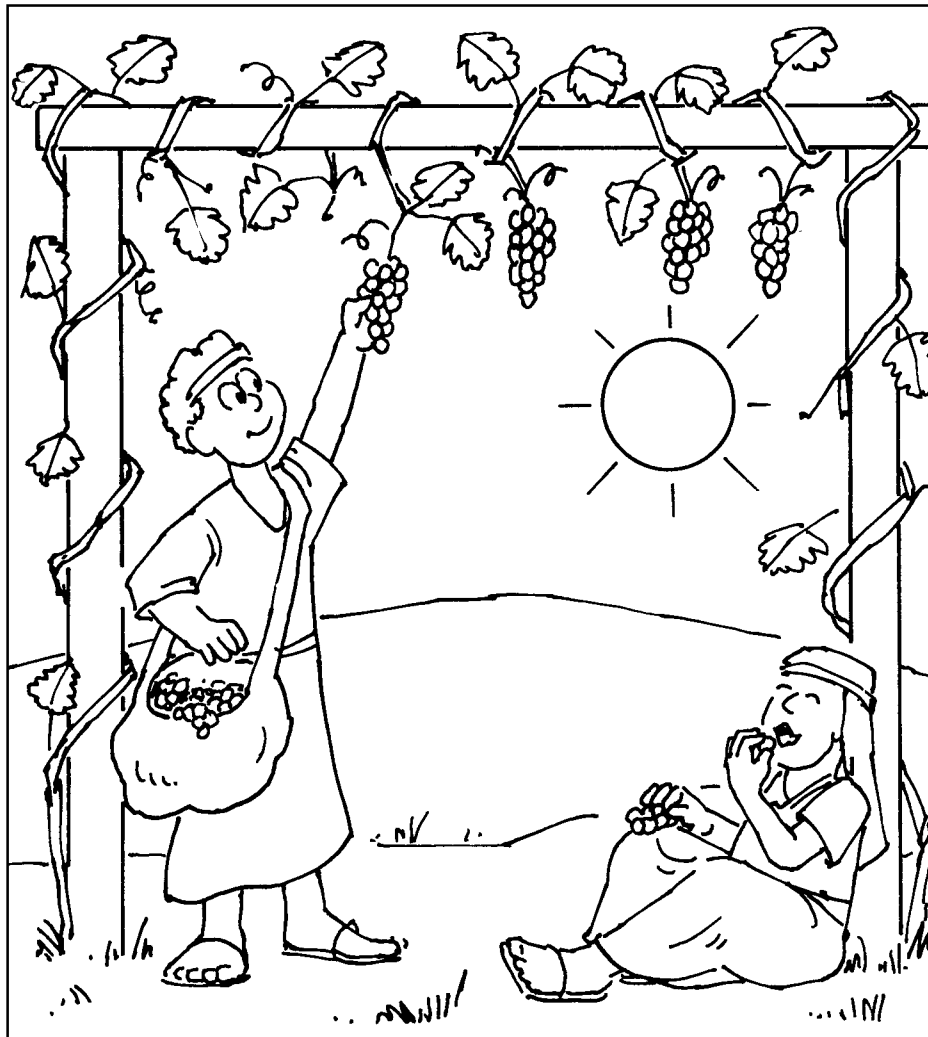
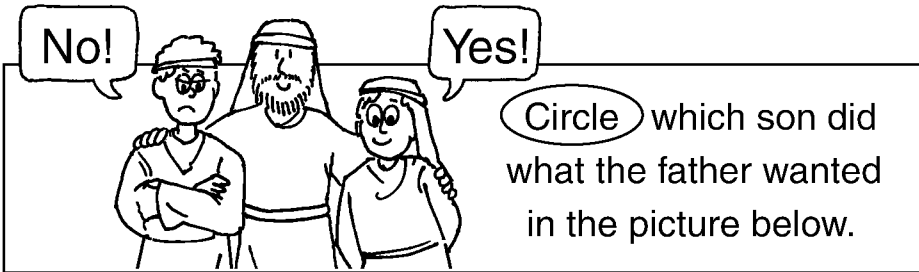

The parable was about the kingdom of God. The chief priests and elders were like the son who said he would go, but didn’t.

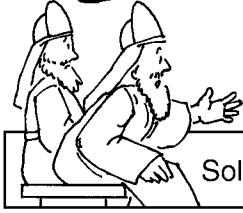
