

Little Bible Heroes: Daniel and the Lions' Den

Listen to our story and then share these activities with your children!

Make a Lion

Cut out a big yellow heart. Now, cut out a smaller orange heart. Glue the orange heart upside down in the middle of the yellow heart. The orange heart will be the lion's nose. Add some eyes and whiskers. This lion will remind you that God always loves you, just like he loved Daniel.

Build a Den

Use legos and make a den for your lions at home! Is your den tall or short, big or little? Create different kinds of dens and then add a lion! Don't have a stuffed animal or toy lion? Use the lion craft above! Have fun retelling our bible story and playing with your lion inside the den.

Roar!

Lions make loud sounds, like a roar! Can you roar like a lion? Can you walk on your hands and feet like a lion? Can you wag your tail like a lion? The lions in our story were also sleepy. Can you pretend to be a sleepy lion?

Brave Breakfast

Take a waffle (or pancake) and add berries for eyes. Next, peel and break apart a clementine. Put the pieces around the waffle to act as the lion's mane. Before you eat, say a prayer and ask God to help you be brave today!

Discuss with your kids:

- 1. Daniel had to be brave, especially when he went into the den. But God was always with him. When was a time you had to be brave?
- 2. Daniel prayed to God morning and night. Can you say a prayer to God when you wake up and when you go to sleep? Try it!
