Elementary

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

Start your kid's day off with some encouraging words, like: “You are so special to me. I'm so glad I'm your parent.”



Meal Time

At a meal this week, say: “Last week, we talked about someone every day that needs help. What are some things you can do (or have done) that would show them that they matter?” (Everyone answer.)



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: “Who are your favorite people to be around?”



Bed Time

Pray for each other: “God, help us to show others they matter in the way we talk or act. Let everyone we encounter know that You value them, and we do too.”



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
